### **About Orchid Awards**

OCTA (Ohio Community Theater Association) holds annual regional theater competitions. The Southwest Region of OCTA (of which Cincinnati is a part) is one of the largest in the country with 20 plus theater groups as members.

ACT (Association of Community Theater); upon request by a member community theater group, will send three judges to critique all aspects of a production, from cast members to lobby displays, from technical aspects to program design. These critiques are done to determine if any individual, group or aspect of a production will win an Orchid Award that season.

To be considered nominated for an Orchid Award one judge has to nominate the person, group or aspect, for the award. If two or three judges nominate then the Orchid Award is won.



# 2017 LSC Creative Arts Scholarship Winner Revealed!



Max Shilling, a Loveland High School 2017 graduate, is the recipient of the \$1000 Loveland Stage Company Creative Arts Scholarship.

Max plans to attend Kent State University to study theater management and production. He has been active in the Loveland Stage Company and the Loveland High School drama program.

Max had his first stage experience in Loveland Stage Company's summer theater production of Carnival in 2012. Since then he has appeared in every LSC summer theater workshop and worked back stage for many of the other shows during the school year. This summer he will be portraying Charles (Charlemagne) in LSC's summer workshop production of Pippin.

At Loveland High School, he has been in main stage productions as well as those put on by the local Thespian Society. He most recently appeared, very briefly before being shot dead, as Rudi Scherz in A Murder is Announced. Last fall, he shaved his head to portray Uncle Fester in LHS' The Addams Family, earning the Director's Award for the most dedicated cast member.


