

About Bugsy Malone Jr.

This pint-sized, pinstriped classic is a tongue-in-cheek tribute to the gangster films of the 1920's. Two gangs comprised completely of children, square off in a 1920's rivalry of Capone-ian standards. Dandy Dan's gang has gotten the upper hand since acquiring the "splurge" gun (a weapon that shoots whipped cream). Bugsy Malone, a one-time boxer, is thrust into the limelight when he becomes the last chance Fat Sam's gang has of surviving. All Bugsy really wants to do is spend time with his new love, Blousey... but that just isn't in the cards for our hero.

All on-line ticket sales are final; sorry, but no refunds or exchanges. On-line ticket sales close 12 hours before performance time.


Tickets for Handicapped (Wheelchair) Seating



SPOTLIGHT ON JENNA SCHROEDER

Prompter - When and how did you become involved in LSC?

I got involved a few years ago when I auditioned for A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum. I scored a small role in this farce musical, and really enjoyed my time getting to know everyone in the show. It was just so much fun both on and off the stage and I am still friends with that cast and production team today.

Prompter - When you are not at the theater, what do you do?

I have four kids, so most of my time is spent cooking in my kitchen! Other than raising a family, I do have a few side gigs. I am a Labor Doula and support women in their births a few times a year. I also have taught dance for over a decade, so I still enjoy both choreographing and performing when I have the chance. I am into natural things and sell non-toxic personal care products through www.beautycounter.com/jennaschroeder. I volunteer for organizations that mean a lot to me, I have a great group of friends that I enjoy spending time with, and once in awhile my husband and I get to go on a date!

Prompter - Why theater? Why LSC?

I discovered theater when I was in high school and started out with dancer and ensemble roles. Eventually, I really began to enjoy the craft of acting and the friendships I would make along the way. I worked my way up to lead roles that were both serious and comical. I kept up with it in college and did shows at BGSU. I stepped back from theater for a long time, focusing on dance and taking care of babies, but once I felt ready to try again I chose LSC because it's a part of my community and I wanted to be a bigger part of it. The people are so kind, fun and supportive! There are so many things I love about it. The classic old theater in historic Loveland is a treasure. The people that volunteer there and make it what it is are like gold. Theater is therapeutic to me, I can tell is good for my soul because I am always happier leaving a rehearsal than I was going into it. It's both creative and challenging. It pushes you out of your comfort level, and sometimes it's the only place you feel comfortable! I love exploring a character, learning new music, dancing with friends, and working with people of all ages and backgrounds. This is what community and the arts is about and LSC captures this marvelously! It's very welcoming, and though I felt nervous when I first entered the scene, I now feel a sense of home and family whenever I am there.

Prompter - What have you been involved in at LSC?

I have been in A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum, Memphis (although I tore my acl at dress rehearsal at this show and wasn't able to be in the performance), Sorry Wrong Number, The Hitchhiker, and currently I am playing Lisa in Mamma Mia!. I also enjoy Margie's dance classes from time to time on Saturday mornings and was in the 4th of July parade. My daughter has been in the youth programs as well. She did Willy Wonka and now she is Dotty in Bugsy Malone Jr. It's been fun to get her involved as well, it's a great opportunity for kids to explore all aspects of the stage, set design, tech and performance in the summer.

Prompter - Where do you see LSC 10 years from now?

I see LSC putting on fabulous shows! My hope is that more and more people flock to the theater as part of their evening out. Downtown Loveland has so many great places to eat and grab a drink, I think the popularity of going to a show afterward will increase. I think more people are also wanting to try new things or go back to things they enjoy, so I could see new talent, ideas, and people mixing into the beauty of the long time members of LSC. I also imagine, that it could be a venue for more than musicals and plays, but different types of shows too! Because I am a dancer at heart it would be neat to see dance performances or other artistic collaborations take place. I love how LSC is open to new ideas, but above all it is always there for its community! The desire to put on high quality performances experiences for the people of Loveland will never change.

Prompter - What would you like to say to LSC and the members?

I would just want to say thank you. Thanks for welcoming me as part of the family, for making me feel valued and loved every time I am there. You all actually amaze me with your talent, your time, and your efforts to make it a great place to be and to put on quality performances. I appreciate you all and look forward to making more memories together! Keep up the good work, the love, the integrity, the collaboration, and the positive atmosphere! 
